## Ambulatory Care Center Covington, KY



This new, three-story full-service Ambulatory Care Center and Emergency Department, anticipated to be completed in January 2009, will provide many necessary services to this growing area of northern Kentucky. The collaboration of the Health System and a local physician-practice provider has a vision of creating a 'Gateway for Health' all-inclusive facility to provide an array of outpatient healthcare services.

This new 'front door' for the City of Covington will provide Emergency Services, primary and speciality physician services, and imaging & diagnostic services, as well as many other outpatient services. St. Elizabeth's currently hard-to-reach Emergency Department, also in Covington, will be replaced by this accessible location on Interstate 75.
